
The people involved in the project have witnessed the humanitarian chain that has been created and has helped thousands of people in Ukraine.



OUR WORK

The G4U project has provided around 300 tons of aid to villages and churches in hot spots, animal shelters and rescuers, hospitals and primary health centers, psychiatric and neurological centers, children's, senior and rehabilitation centers, Azov, frontline and special forces brigades, LGBTQIA* community, IDP centers, paramedics, rescuers and firefighters.

HOW DO WE MAKE AN IMPACT ON SOCIETY?

We raise awareness about the situation in Ukraine and those who fled to Berlin as a result of the full scale war.

Through our work, the volunteers, who are predominantly young and international, are able to see the situation in Ukraine in a different perspective than in the news. On a more personal level and through compassion and empathy for the affected people, we witness how acting in solidarity helps a person affected by the russian aggression to feel not ignored, but supported and hopeful.

In the same way, we witness how a chain of solidarity among the Berlin community is forming strongly, making everyone aware of the value of life and the right to live free and without fear.

WHAT ARE OUR CURRENT NEEDS?

- An office space or conference room for Berlin to borders for a bi-monthly core team coordination
- Monthly income for the G4U project expenses: around 3000 euros per month (warehouse, fuel and shipments of Humanitarian Aid, events & workshops)
- Possible Partner for Transportation


